

NOTIFICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE REGISTRATION

RE: ORDER OF WEIGHING AND MEASURING INSTRUMENT INTO THE KINGDOM

In accordance with the Department of Commerce Registration dated the 1st of December B.E. 2513, it prescribes an inspection and verification of a weighing and measuring instrument under the metric and other systems displaying together:

The Department of Commerce Registration hereby respites and issues the rules as follows:

1. if a weighing and measuring instrument under the metric and other systems displaying together ordered from a foreign country prior to the 1st of December B.E. 2513, and if it is imported into the Kingdom by the 30th of April B.E. 2514, the Department of Commerce Registration shall respite the former rule by inspecting but not granting verification. In this regard, Letter of Credit (L/C) shall be submitted to illustrate that such weighing and measuring instrument was ordered prior to the 1st of December B.E. 2513;

2. if a weighing and measuring instrument under the metric and other systems displaying together which is ordered from a foreign country after the 1st of December B.E. 2513, regardless of whether it was imported, such weighing and measuring instrument shall be brought for inspection and verification by a competent official and shall affix a clear and indelible mark “for the use of (weighing, volume or length measuring) sale under the metric system only” on a weighing machine, volume measuring device or length measurer, as the case may be, clearly and indelible.
