

**Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures**

Regarding Prescription on Form of Verification Certificate (No. 3),  
B.E. 2566 (2023)

Whereas the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures already issued the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), dated 8<sup>th</sup> September B.E. 2559 (2016) as amended by the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate (No. 2) B.E. 2564 (2021), dated 21<sup>st</sup> January B.E. 2564 (2021), prescribing the form of a verification certificate by a competent official, an agency entrusted by the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade under Section 31 or a permit holder acting as an inspector and providing the verification of measuring instruments which are manufactured or repaired by such a permit holder under Section 41 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999).

In order that the issuance of the verification certificate via the system of measurement work by electronic means shall be convenient, rapid and able to monitor measuring instruments at all times resulting in enhancement in official operation and in compliance with the government's policy on providing services by an electronic system and the law on carrying out of public service via electronic means; by virtue of Section 6 (3), (5) of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) and paragraph four of Section 30 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) as amended by the Measurement Act (No. 3), B.E. 2557 (2014), the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade therefore issues this Notification, as follows.

**Article 1.** This Notification shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.<sup>1</sup>

**Article 2.** The following provisions shall be added as (10), (11) and (12) of Article 3 of the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), dated 8<sup>th</sup> September B.E. 2559 (2016) as amended by the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate (No. 2) B.E. 2564 (2021), dated 21<sup>st</sup> January B.E. 2564 (2021) :

“(10) the form of a verification certificate in the form of sealing strip issued from the system of measurement work by electronic means and issued by a competent official (Form ChorVor. 3010) (Form Square Sealing Strip with a QR code picture),

(11) the form of a verification certificate in the form of sealing strip issued from the system of measurement work by electronic means and issued by a government sector, a state agency, a state organization, a state enterprise or an office under Section 31 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) (Form ChorVor. 3011) (Form Square Sealing Strip with a QR code picture),

(12) the form of a verification certificate in the form of sealing strip issued from the system of measurement work by electronic means and issued by a permit holder under Section 41 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) (Form ChorVor. 3012) (Form Square Sealing Strip with a QR code picture)”.

**Article 3.** The provision in paragraph two of Article 3 of the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), Dated 8<sup>th</sup> September B.E. 2559 (2016) as amended by the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate (No. 2) B.E. 2564 (2021), dated 21<sup>st</sup> January B.E. 2564 (2021) shall be repealed, and the following provision shall be replaced.

“The forms of a verification certificate under (3), (4), (5), (6), (8), (9), (10), (11) and (12) shall be made in the form of a sealing strip to be stuck on a measuring instrument in the manner that when such a sealing strip is removed, it shall be separated from each other or defective and unable to be used again, whereby the sealing strip shall have a size suitable”.

**Article 4.** The following provisions shall be added as paragraph three of Article 3 of the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), dated 8<sup>th</sup> September B.E. 2559 (2016) as amended by the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate (No. 2) B.E. 2564 (2021), dated 21<sup>st</sup> January B.E. 2564 (2021) :

“In presenting information via a QR code picture by electronic means pursuant to the forms of a verification certificate under (10), (11) and (12), there shall be the following information at least:

- (1) a serial number of instrument,
- (2) a type of measuring instrument,
- (3) an official who inspects and provides verification,
- (4) the date of inspection and verification,
- (5) the expiry date of verification (if any)".
