

MINISTERIAL REGULATION NO. 16 (B.E. 2525) (1982)

ISSUED UNDER THE COMMODITIES CONTROL ACT B.E. 2495

---

By virtue of section 11 of the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495, the Minister of Interior and the Minister of Economics hereby issue the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

**Clause 1.** Ministerial Regulation No. 12 (B.E. 2522) issued under the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495 shall be repealed.

**Clause 2.** The following *ex officio* persons shall be competent officials for the execution of the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495 or the Royal Decree issued under the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495:

(1) For every province:

- (a) Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade;
- (b) Deputy Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade;
- (c) Civil servants of the Department of Internal Trade who are in level 2

and above;

(2) For Bangkok;

- (a) Governor of Bangkok;
- (b) Bangkok Sheriff;
- (c) District Chief;
- (d) Police officer from the position of Police Sub-Lieutenant;
- (e) Inspector of the Weight and Measure under the Commercial Registration

Department

In this regard, this is in the locality or jurisdiction.

(3) For other provinces outside Bangkok:

- (a) Provincial Governor;
- (b) Vice Provincial Governor;
- (c) Deputy Governor;

- (d) Inspector for Commerce;
- (e) Inspector General;
- (f) Provincial Commerce officer;
- (g) Sheriff;
- (h) District Chief who is the chief of sub-district;
- (i) District Chief;
- (j) Police officer from the position of Police Sub-Lieutenant;
- (k) Civil servants in the Provincial Commerce Office who are in the level of 2

and above.

In this regard, it shall be within the locality or jurisdiction.

Remark: the rationale for the promulgation of this Ministerial Regulation: Ministerial Regulation No. 12 (B.E. 2522) issued under the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495 appointing competent officials for the execution of the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495 or the Royal Decree issued under the Commodities Control Act B.E. 2495 is not sufficient for the execution of this law and, thereby, it is expedient to amend such Ministerial Regulation by additionally appointing Governor of Bangkok, District Chief who is the chief of sub-district, and civil servants of the Department of Internal Trade who are in level 2 and above to be competent officials for the execution of work relating to the law on commodities control to increase facilitation and efficiency and therefore it is necessary to issue this Ministerial Regulation.
