At present, the use of scales is used to determine the percentage of starch in the kernel. To set the price in the same trading as many. In conjunction with the holder of the license, the repair of the weighing instrument has been approved for the business of scales. The Director-General of the Department of Commercial Registration issued the order No. 229/2523 dated November 3, 1980, defining the standard, appearance, and certification of the scales. This results in the scales being legally weighed as of the date of inspection. Therefore, this type of weighing machine has to be checked by the authorities as well as other scales. From the date of issue order. To make use of such scales in a correct, correct and fair manner with the buyer and the seller. Department of Trade Registration He advised on how to use the scales to find the percentage of starch in the bean, dated November 10, 1980, so that buyers and sellers of tapioca products could use it as a guideline.

However, at present, in addition to the use of illegal scales, there are also some buyers who are dishonest in tapioca production. Have used various methods. To exploit such as let the water do not use fresh water. Or clean water Some of them add salt or chemicals to the water, for example, by desiccating the percentage of starch in the water, in dirty water, salt water, or sea water, or water containing chemical impurities. Will cause the starch percentage in the head is wrong from the fact.

The Department of Commercial Registration is cautioned to know that. Actions or omissions the use of scales to find the percentage of flour in the head. To make the value of starch flour in the head wrong, from reality is a reality. It is an offense and may be punished by law.

Whenever anyone finds or suspects that scales are being used, the percentage of starch in the wrong head is used. Please inform the weighing staff immediately. Report to the Department of Trade Statistics. Ministry of Commerce or measuring office
