

Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures

Regarding Prescription on Application Form for Registration of Identification Mark
and Change in Identification Mark¹

Whereas the Ministerial Regulation Laying down Rules Governing Business Operation in respect of Measurement and Registration of Identification Mark, B.E. 2563 (2020) issued under the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) and as amended has prescribed that the Central Bureau is empowered to prescribe an application form for the registration of an identification mark and change in the registered identification mark.

In order that the registration of the identification mark and the registration of the change in the registered identification mark of the business operator in the manufacture, import or repair of measuring instruments shall be in order, by virtue of Article 3 and Article 10 of the Ministerial Regulation Laying down Rules Governing Business Operation in respect of Measurement and Registration of Identification Mark, B.E. 2563 (2020), the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade therefore issues this Notification, as follows.

Article 1. This Notification shall come into force as from the date of its publication.

Article 2. The application for the registration of the identification mark and the change in the identification mark shall be in accordance with Form ChorVor. 40 – 001 as attached to this Notification.
