

Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures

Regarding Prescription on Form of Verification Certificate (No. 2),
B.E. 2564 (2021)

Whereas the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures already issued the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), Dated 8 September B.E. 2559 (2016) prescribing the form of a verification certificate by a competent official or a permit holder acting as an inspector and providing the verification of measuring instruments which are manufactured or repaired by such a permit holder under Section 41 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999).

Whereas Section 31 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) has stipulated that the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade may request a government sector, a state agency, a state organization, a state enterprise, or a foreign or international measurement office or organization to inspect and to provide the verification of measuring instruments under the rules, conditions and procedures laid down by the Director-General; and such inspection shall be deemed the inspection by using a standard and the verification by the competent official pursuant to the law governing measurement.

In order that the issuance of the verification certificate of the measuring instruments by the government sector, the state agency, the state organization, the state enterprise, or the aforesaid office shall be correct, in good order and the same way; by virtue of Article 6 (3), (5) of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) and Article 30 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) as amended by the Measurement Act (No. 3), B.E. 2557 (2014), the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade therefore issues this Notification, as follows.

Article 1. This Notification shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.¹

Article 2. The following provisions shall be added as (7), (8) and (9) of Article 3 of the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), dated 8 September B.E. 2559 (2016).

“(7) The form of a verification certificate issued by a government sector, a state agency, a state organization, a state enterprise or an office under Section 31 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) (Form ChorVor.3007)”,

“(8) The form of a verification certificate in the form of sealing strip issued by a government sector, a state agency, a state organization, a state enterprise or an office under Section 31 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) (Form ChorVor. 3008) (Form Circle Sealing Strip)”,

“(9) The form of a verification certificate in the form of sealing strip issued by a government sector, a state agency, a state organization, a state enterprise or an office under Section 31 of the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999) (Form ChorVor. 3009) (Form Square Sealing Strip)”.

Article 3. The provision in paragraph two of Article 3 of the Notification of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Regarding Prescription of Form of Verification Certificate B.E. 2559 (2016), Dated 8 September B.E. 2559 (2016) shall be repealed, and the following provision shall be replaced.

“The forms of a verification certificate under (3), (4), (5), (6), (8) and (9) shall be made in the form of a sealing strip to be stuck on a measuring instrument in the manner that if such a sealing strip is pried off, it shall be separated from each other or defective and unable to be used again, whereby the sealing strip shall have a size suitable to that of the measuring instrument”.
