

Regulation of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures
Governing Calibration Procedure of Automatic Weighing Instrument for Weighing
Vehicle in Motion by Weighing One Axle for Each Time,
B.E. 2566 (2023)

In order that the procedure for calibrating the automatic weighing instrument for weighing the vehicle in motion by weighing one axle for each time shall be correct, standardized and fair to all parties relevant to weighing, the Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade therefore issues this Regulation, as follows.

Article 1. This Regulation is called the “Regulation of the Central Bureau of Weights and Measures Governing Calibration Procedure of Automatic Weighing Instrument for Weighing Vehicle in Motion by Weighing One Axle for Each Time, B.E. 2566 (2023)”.

Article 2. This Regulation shall come into force as from the date of its publication onwards.

Article 3. In this Regulation,

“WIM weighing instrument” means the automatic weighing instrument for weighing the vehicle in motion by weighing one axle for each time (Weight in Motion : WIM).

Article 4. A person who wishes to calibrate the WIM weighing instrument shall submit an application under the application form for the calibration of measuring instruments under the Measurement Act, B.E. 2542 (1999). The application form can be downloaded via the website of the Measurement Division (www.cbwmthai.org). The application form together with the form of recording the result of inspecting equipment and the system of the WIM weighing instrument shall be submitted to a competent official at the Central Bureau or the Branch Bureau which has jurisdiction in a province in which the WIM weighing instrument is located, as the case may be.

Article 5. In calibrating the WIM weighing instrument, the competent official shall follow the manual of the calibration procedure of the automatic weighing instrument for weighing the vehicle in motion by weighing one axle for each time as attached to this Regulation.

Article 6. The competent official under the law governing measurement shall be an calibrating inspector, and the Director of the Group of Weighing Instrument Standard, the Measurement Division, who performs a duty at the Central Bureau, or the chief of the Branch Bureau, shall be the person who considers the approval of the result of the calibration of the WIM weighing instrument before delivering the result report to the applicant under Article 4.

Article 7. The applicant under Article 4 shall appropriately facilitate the competent official's performance of a duty to calibrate.

Article 8. The Director-General of the Department of Internal Trade shall have charge and control of the execution of this Regulation.
