

NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE

RE: PRESCRIPTION OF TYPE OF WEIGHING AND MEASURING INSTRUMENT ATTACHED AND
IMMOVABLE WHICH HAS BEEN INSPECTED AND UPON BEING MOVED TO BE INSTALLED, IT
MUST BE INSPECTED FOR ACCURACY

B.E. 2552 (2009)

In respect of a weighing and measuring instrument attached and immovable which has been inspected and upon being moved to be installed, it must be inspected for accuracy again to ensure that a weighing and measuring instrument is correct and accurate before using such weighing and measuring instrument for operation under section 25 paragraph one of the Weights and Measures Act B.E. 2542.

By virtue of section 5 and section 27 of the Weights and Measures Act B.E. 2542 is the Act containing certain provisions in relation to the restriction of rights and liberties of a person, in respect of which section 29 in conjunction with section 32, section 33, section 41 and section 43 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by the virtue of law, the Minister of Commerce hereby issues the Notification rules as follows:

Clause 1. This Notification shall come into force upon the expiration of sixty days from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Clause 2. A weighing and measuring instrument attached and immovable under the list as annexed to this Notification which has been inspected and upon moving it, a possessor of such weighting and measuring instrument shall inform, in writing, to the Central Bureau or subsidiary office within fifteen days as from the date of completion of installation for a competent official to inspect the accuracy of such weighing and measuring instrument before being further used in operation under section 25 paragraph one of the Weights and Measures Act B.E. 2542.
