

## NOTIFICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE REGISTRATION

### RE: AFFIX OF VERIFICATION MARK FOR FUEL PUMP

As the Department of Commerce Registration has amended the means to wire for affixing a verification mark of fuel pump under the brand TOKHEIM and WAYNE to be stricter to prevent any person from conducting fraud to modify a fuel pump easily as follows:

The brand TOKHEIM using copper wire twisting without any joint attaching with fuel adjustment to prevent an affix being torn and putting through the center of fuel adjustment to prevent the knot from being modified, going through a knot attaching the engine below as drilled to prevent the engine below from being modified and putting the lead and affix a verification mark. Every part which is wired must twist the copper and stretch it.

Wiring through a knot attaching the engine below may be put through at the front of the engine or the back of the engine which shall be seen clearly upon affixing a verification mark.

The brand WAYNE must be made from twisted copper attaching the fuel adjustment to prevent the knot from being lifted to adjust the fuel and put the lead and affix a verification mark and use the twisted copper to twist the knot to attach the lid especially on the width on both sides to prevent the knots from opening the lid and putting through the lid and attach a verification mark as well.

As illustrated in the photo illustrating copper twisted wire of a fuel pump under the brand TOKHEIM and WAYNE as annexed with this Notification.

The notification is, therefore, announced.
